Ordinance No. **2009-01-19**

Adopting an Official Map for the Town of Warren; St. Croix County, Wisconsin

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes the importance of reserving lands to allow the logical, cost-effective, and community supported location of future public facilities, including but not limited to the future right-of-way for the proposed Highway 65 bypass, and

WHEREAS, Sections 60.62, 61.35, and 62.23(6) of Wisconsin Statutes authorize towns that have adopted village powers to also adopt an Official Map, the purpose of which is to assure that lands identified future public purpose may be reserved for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Warren has allowed for public comment on the Official Map, has noticed and held a public hearing on the Official Map, and has obtained a recommendation from its plan commission on the Official Map.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Warren adopts this Official Map as an ordinance of the Town of Warren, with said Map carrying all of the authority provided to it and the Town under Section 62.23(6) of Wisconsin Statutes, and with such Map subject to future amendment as determined necessary by the Town Board and as provided under Section 62.23(6).
