**TITLE 10, Chapter 4 – PREVENTING MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN THE  
TOWN PARK**

**AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE TITLE 10, Chapter 4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF  
THE TOWN OF WARREN RELATING TO MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN THE TOWN  
PARK**

**THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WARREN, WISCONSIN DOES ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:**

**Whereas:** The Town Board of the Town of Warren, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Wisconsin Statute § 350.18 to adopt this ordinance; and

**Whereas:** The Town Board has determined that the use of snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles or other motorized vehicles in the Town Park is detrimental to the ecology of the park and may be a dangerous hazard to other users of the Park:

**Therefore,** the Town Board of the Town of Warren does ordain as follows:

**Title 10, Chapter 4 is hereby created to read as follows:**

**Sec. 10-4-1 PREVENTING MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN THE TOWN  
PARK.**

- (a) **Motorized Vehicles Prevented in Town Park.** No person may operate an all-terrain vehicle as defined in Wisconsin Statutes § 340.01 (2g), a snowmobile, as defined in Wisconsin Statutes § 340.01 (58a), or any motorized vehicle of any kind with the Town of Warren Park or on Town of Warren property, except within the confines of the town road right of way as permitted under sec. 10-3-2 or otherwise permitted by state statutes.
- (b) **Exception.** This section shall not apply to maintenance vehicles owned or contracted by the Town.
- (c) **Penalties.** Any person violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) nor more than Two

Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the County jail until the same are paid, for a period of time not to exceed thirty (30) days.

This ordinance was adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under Wis. Stat. § 60.80. This ordinance becomes effective after posting or publishing, upon the placement of appropriate speed limits signs.
