

Town of Warren  
Ordinance  
Prohibiting Firearms and Dangerous Weapons  
In Warren Town Hall

Section 11-2-5 of the Ordinances of the Town of Warren is created to read as follows:

- A. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to create and preserve a safe and peaceful environment for the conduct of the business of the Town and for the users of the Town facility.
- B. Pursuant to Wis. Stats. 943.3(1m)(C)4, no person shall enter or remain the Town of Warren town hall while possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapons as defined in Section 939.22(10) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- C. The Town Clerk shall cause signs to be erected at all entrances to the building providing notice that no person is to enter or remain in any such building while carrying a firearm or dangerous weapon. Such signs shall be five inches by seven inches or larger.
- D. There shall be an exception to the prohibition contained in this Ordinance for the instructor and attendees of a scheduled hunter safety class or any other excepted activity that is designated by resolution of the Town Board.
- E. The prohibition contained in this Ordinance shall not apply to a police officer, sheriff or sheriff's deputy or member of the armed services that are in the building pursuant in their line of duty.
